## Karen Drucker Concert and Workshop Details

Karen Drucker's performances and workshops consist of live vocals performed to pre-recorded "tracks" (either on Ipad or on a CD), as well as singing and playing piano. For a concert or workshop situation, the Ipad must be on stage with Karen for her to cue the tracks herself. The following items are necessary for Karen Drucker's performance:

- 1. P.A. System: 4-8 or more channel mixer with reverb; minimum of 2 speakers on stands placed on either side of the stage. P.A. should be powerful enough for multiple vocals and coverage for size of the room.
- **2. Monitors:** One or two monitors to be placed on the stage in front of Karen.
- 3. Direct box for Ipad or a CD Player: Includes all cords that plug into the sound system. Since Karen always uses "tracks" during her performance, it is very important that there is a direct box that goes through the P.A. system.
- **4. Piano or Electronic Keyboard:** An acoustic piano (meaning no electricity required a baby grand or upright). Electric piano or digital piano must be a <u>professional series 88-note weighted action</u> digital piano. It should also include an AC adapter, sustain pedal, "guitar" cables to plug into P.A., a keyboard stand, and bench or stool. Piano is placed stage right from the center of the stage and is on the highest setting to allow for Karen standing and playing.

## 5. Other items:

- a. Water in a glass on stage. No plastic water bottles please.
- b. A 6-foot table located in the main area of audience traffic.
- c. One or two volunteers to help with selling Karen's products.
- d. If there is a backstage area: water/mirror/healthy munchies are appreciated.
- e. No taping of the concert without prior agreement/permission from Karen.
- f. Scheduled sound check required at least an hour before the event with the sound technician.
- g. Stairs in the front of the stage to have access for walking through the audience.

## 6. Show requirements:

- a. DVD player and screen for DVDs during show (someone to operate) (let us know if you don't have this)
- b. One boom stand with mic at the keyboard
- c. Two straight stands with mic (wireless mic is always preferred) (2nd stand hold the Ipad)
- d. One music stand (Manhasset black stand is the best)
- e. One small table to hold Karen's props and notes.
- f. Tall stool without arms

## 7. Workshop Requirements:

- a. Chairs placed in a large circle with enough room to be able to add any late arrivals.
- b. Enough room so that the chairs can be broken down into groups of 4-6 people.
- c. A volunteer who can monitor the lights, room temperature, people coming in, handing things out, etc.
- d. People should be asked beforehand to bring a journal and pen. Paper and pens should also be available
- e. Name tags provided either the kind that hang around your neck, or the peel and stick kind.
